Dear Beloved Andre House Community,

At Andre House, we offer dignity and hospitality to all who pass through our door. In 2021 and 2022, the COVID-19 pandemic had us reimagining what our "doorway" looked like, along with our meal prep, clothing, showers, hygiene and laundry services to our dear friends in need. We asked our volunteers to mask up and socially distance, we passed meals out of our loading dock door, we partnered with local restaurants to help cook and prepare dinners, and through it all, we sustained our primary ministry of ensuring none of our brothers and sisters went hungry each night.

The pandemic left more of our friends houseless, both in shelters and unsheltered in tents each night over the past 2 years, with the number of folks on our block growing from 1,000 to 2,000 per night. We therefore took the exceptional generosity showed to us by all of you, our supporters, and expanded our Targeted Guest Assistance program significantly during the pandemic. We were able to help several hundred individuals and families with rent/utility assistance, hotel fare, transportation assistance, obtaining ID's, medical cost assistance, fine & fee payments, car repairs, obtaining COVID stimulus payments and bus passes. These past two years certainly posed many challenges for our guests, and yet I am truly inspired at how so many dedicated, compassionate, kind and truly selfless volunteers, donors, partners and our staff stepped up to show our guests the dignity, hospitality and love they truly deserve. Thank you truly, for helping us to carry on God's work.

THE PEOPLE WE SERVE

Due to the pandemic there was no count of individuals experiencing homelessness in Maricopa County. During

this time unsheltered individuals in tents were made to reside in large county

parking lots. In late 2021 the lots were closed and unsheltered individuals created tent homes


surrounding Andre House and in the streets of the "Zone."

On the night of January 24, 2022, there were *9,026* individuals experiencing homelessness in Maricopa County. 44% are sheltered. 56% are unsheltered.

Andre House welcomes and provides service to all of these individuals.



The Andre House Core Staff is the lifeblood of Andre House. They spend at least 10 hours a day at our Hospitality Center providing services and love to our guests experiencing homelessness.. They make a year or more commitment to service. Our 2020-2021 Core spent the entire time in our Andre House pandemic mode, providing meals from the loading dock and adjusted services. Our 2021-2022 Core staff started in that mode and had to navigate switching over to our former in house meal and service model. Both served with strength and flexible during very difficult times.



In 2020, during the Covid pandemic, Andre House was blessed to be able to bring back and sustain small teams of volunteers to prepare and serve meals. The dining room remained closed and meals continued to be served in take-out containers from our loading dock. On Monday, August 30, 2021, we fully reopened our dining room and inside services. Since then our volunteer numbers have been rebuilding as we work to provide hospitality to all who come through our doors.




