


ABOUT ANDRE HOUSE

Andre house is a homeless services agency in downtown Phoenix that focuses on meeting the immediate, basic needs of people experiencing homelessness. We are located across the street from the Human Services Campus, the city's most comprehensive resource for individuals experiencing homelessness. Our main service is the dinner meal for the area and we provide a variety of hospitality and spiritual services such as showers, laundry, a clothing closet, daily mass and an office where we distribute blankets, backpacks, hygiene kits and access to phones and charging stations. Additionally, we run a men's transitional house not far from the hospitality center.

HOMELESSNESS IN PHOENIX

According to the annual Point in Time Count there were **7,419 people experiencing homelessness** in Maricopa County, including **3,767 persons sleeping on the streets** or in another place not meant for human habitation. Unsheltered homelessness accoutns for roughly **51% of the total homeless population**.

DONATION DRIVE FAQ

What types of items should I donate?

Andre House serves people experiencing homelessness, so items of practical use that meet basic needs such as hygiene items, clothing, blankets, backpacks are needed year round. **Please reference the wish list** included in this kit for a



complete list of specific needs and contact Andre House before your drive to see what's at the top of our most needed list.

What types of items should I not donate?

Because our meal service depends on consistent mass quantities of specific types of food, **food donations are accepted on a case by case basis and generally not recommended**. We typically accept mass quantities of non-perishable snack items (think granola bars, fruit cups, single serve crackers or popcorn). **If you have food that you would like to donate to Andre House, please call ahead to find out if we can accept.** Also, consider donating food to St. Mary's Food Bank our community partner who supplies much of our food.

Items we reject upon arrival: High heel shoes Elegant women's clothing Pajamas/Bathrobes Children's clothing Toys Inappropriate clothing (disrespectful, alcohol, drug, sex themes, etc.) Clothing with business labels that would enable a person to impersonate an employee

How do I get my donations to you?

Donations can be dropped off at Andre House Monday-Thursday 10:30AM-12PM and 1:30PM-4PM. We strongly encourage weekday drop offs but we do accept donations on weekends as well-Saturdays and Sundays 2-4PM. No appointment needed for drop off, but if you have a large donation (full bed of a pickup truck, full minivan or SUV), please let us know in advance so we can prepare with the appropriate staff. Can I donate money?

Yes! Monetary donations are the most efficient and effective way to support our work. Andre House receives no money from federal, state, county or municipal entities and we rely on the generous support of individual and corporate donors and private foundations. We kindly ask that donations of clothing, blankets and backpacks be used or gently used and laundered before donating if possible. Because our staff's time is prioritized for direct service to our guests, we appreciate and prefer presorted donations!

Hygiene items are an every day need for our guests. We distribute hygiene kits in the office and guests can take showers at Andre House.We welcome pre-packaged kits that include all of our essentials (guide on the next page for assembling).
